



ACFE Foundation Charity Poker Tournament

NO LIMIT Texas Hold’Em – \$125

1. The initial \$125 buy-in is divided: \$100 contributed to the ACFE Foundation, \$25 for house fee and tournament staff.
2. Players will start with \$5,000 in tournament chips. A player may re-enter if they lose all their chips for the 1st hour of play. A re-entry is \$100 for \$5,000 in tournament chips. 100% of the re-entry fee is a contribution to the ACFE Foundation.
3. Tournament will consist of up to 11 levels. Levels 1-10 will last 20 minutes. The final level (#11) will have no time limit. There will be a 10 (ten) minute break after rounds 3 and 6. See Schedule of Play.
4. A player may forfeit their chips at any time during the tournament.
5. A 5 (five) minute break will occur once players at the final table have been established.
6. The payout structure is as follows:
